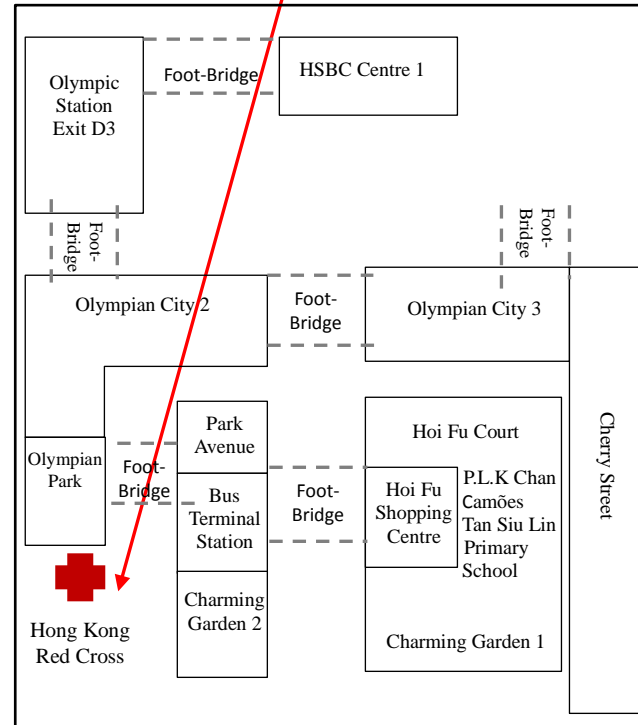

Virginia Satir, used to say: “Sameness attracts. Differences help us grow.” But for most of us differences make us fight and feel unhappy. In family life, differences often destroy the possibility of happiness and generate a lot of conflicts.
