

Hong Kong Satir Center For Human Development President Report 2023

The year of 2023 is still a challenging year for the Hong Kong community and our Centre. Fighting the epidemic could be tiring and exhausting, and it was natural to feel anxious in the state of uncertainty. As our daily routines restored, our vision was revisited and we had a clearer mission on the betterment of our society through quality counseling services for individuals and families and professional training for counselors and therapists. For counseling and supervision, we had a team of 86 senior and voluntary counselors and 14 supervisors. There were totally 544 cases and among which 430 were new ones, and the total number of counseling sessions was 3,073. To cater for those who had financial difficulties, fee waving was arranged for individual cases and the counseling program 'Walk with You' launched in August 2022. With these measures, counseling services with reduced rate were provided for 14 cases, and special rate for 175 cases. In view of this, the counseling program "Walk with You" will be extended to the next year. To uphold the quality of counseling services, 269 supervision sessions were provided for our counsellors. The Board would like to express our heartfelt appreciation and gratitude to our counsellors and supervisors who brought hopes and confidence to the service users.

For programs and courses, there were totally 34 programs conducted including 6 personal growth experiential workshops, 16 professional training, 10 service delivery by invitation (SDI) and 2 talks/ online talks. None of these would have been possible without the contribution of Dr. Marie Lam who provided 18 personal and professional development programs including 'Exploring the Satir Model of Family Therapy for Personal & Professional Development - LVI', 'Unblock the Blockages - LVII', 'Workshop on Loss and Grief', 'Professional Counseling Certificate Course - PCCC'. Our sincere thanks also give to Ms. Chan Siu Ling who conducted 5 professional training programs including 'Foundation Counseling Course on Satir Model - FCC' and other programs. We would also like to pay special thanks to Dr. John Banmen, Dr. Beth Nemesh, Mr. Man Ka On, Dr. Cat Chung, Ms. Jennifer Chow, Ms. Connie Au, Ms. Angela Wong, Mr. Simon Leung and Mr. Christopher Ng for conducting training programs and talks for our Center and other NGOs. For programs and courses conducted in 2023, there were totally 908 attendances. Please refer to the Profile of the year 2023 for details.

For highlights of training programs, we are glad that with the concerted effort of our trainers and facilitators, the training workshops of the 14th Professional Counseling Certificate Course PCCC-14 were started smoothly and successfully in June 2023. Although overseas trainers could not visit Hong Kong in 2023, our learning with them was not interrupted. Dr. John Banmen gave online training for PCCC14 facilitators. Another online talk 'Creating internal balance using the Mandala of personal resources' was conducted by Dr. Beth Nemesh in October 2023.

For the training to our PCCC trainees and graduates, there were totally 4 in-house training programs conducted in this year, the topics includes Grief Counselling, Trauma Therapy, Therapy with Singing bowl, Sexual and Gender Diversity. We would like to express our appreciation to our PCCC graduates, including Ms. Agnes Tin, Ms. Kam Won, Ms. Wallace Tang and Mr. Chau Chun Yam for the fruitful sharing. Besides, we also concerned about the suicidal issue in Hong Kong recently. In order to provide support for our members and graduates, we had invited Ms. Angela Wong to conduct a special program on "Crisis Management on Suicide Cases" in December 2023.

For membership, we had a total number of 684 members including 177 Life members (Ordinary), 133 Life members (Professional), 257 Affiliate members, 110 Ordinary members and 7 Professional members. We would like to extend our appreciation and gratitude to them for their unfailing support to the Center.

I would like to express my appreciation to the Board of Directors of 2023, including Ms. Lee Wai Ki (Secretary), Mr. Caesar Chan (Treasurer), Ms. Rita Yip and Mr. Kelvin Chung (Program Directors), Mr. Simon Leung and Ms. Celine Lau (Counseling Directors), and Mr. Clarence Ching (Development Director) for their valuable contribution and team work throughout this year. Above all our sincere thanks must go to Ms. Karen Wong (Assistant manager), Ms. Nicole Kwok (Executive Officer), Ms. Perry Ng (Program Officer), Ms. Alena Cheung (Program Assistant) and Ms. Charlie Chai (Clerical Assistants) and Ms. Annie Yu (Part-time Clerical Assistants) for their outstanding team effort which won the compliment of service users and program participants.

Profile for Year 2023

At the end of September 2023, the Center had a total of 544 active cases. From October 2022 to September 2023, we had 86 counselors having offered 3,073 sessions while 14 supervisors offered 269 supervision sessions. Being a charitable organization, the Center granted fee reduction to 14 counseling cases with an estimated subsidy of HK\$24,750.
